

ARCADIA TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION
REGULAR MEETING
November 15, 2022

A regular meeting of the Arcadia Township Planning Commission was held on Tuesday, November 15, 2022 at the Arcadia Township Hall, 4900 Spencer Street, Lum, Michigan. Chairperson Lashbrook opened the meeting at 7:31 p.m. following a public hearing.

NEW BUSINESS

- A) Chairperson Lashbrook shared that this was her last meeting as she has accepted the Deputy Supervisor position, in preparation of Supervisor Howell's resignation at the end of the year to be on the Road Commission Board. Lashbrook will be appointed Supervisor January 1, 2023.
- B) Recording Secretary Gormley passed out a proposed 2023 meeting dates calendar to be reviewed. Approval will take place at the January meeting.

REPORTS

Howe gave a short report as to the township board's matters:

- The Board had a special meeting to do interviews for the Deputy Supervisor position.
- The Board approved All in One Pest Control at \$415.00 for 10 months.
- The Deputy Supervisor position will be paid \$14.00 per hour.
- Right Touch Landscaping was asked to clean up the property lines around the cemetery and pick up the extra dirt dumped in the back. Cost will be \$3,100.00 for the brush clean up and then wait to see what we can do with the extra dirt rather than pay to truck it out.

- \$6,380.00 charge from brush axing in the Township (1/2 of full bill to be split with the Road Commission).
- A Budget Amendment was made to allow for the Deputy Supervisor pay.
- Spaghetti Dinner will be on May 6, 2023 from 4-8pm.
- Township Clean Up Day is also May 6, 2023 from 8-11am.

McClelland stated there was nothing to report on the Zoning Board.
