## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

On June 25, 2025, at 10:00am.

a public hearing will be held at the Arcadia Township Hall, located at 4900 Spencer Street, Attica, Michigan 48412, concerning the proposed township budget for the fiscal year 2025-2026.

The property tax millage rate proposed to be levied to support the proposed budget will be a subject of this hearing.

At the same time and place, a public hearing will be held concerning the Public Safety Special Assessment Budget. The estimated costs and expenses of fire and police protection for the 2025-2026 budget year is approximately \$63,000 and the proposed distribution of the levy for those services is: \$45 for each dwelling unit, commercial building and industrial building, not including garages, sheds or barns.

\$15 for each taxable parcel of property that is vacant or contains no dwelling unit, commercial building, or industrial building.

The estimate and proposed distribution of levy is the same as when the Special Assessment District was established in 2001.

A person wishing to support or object to the Public Safety Special Assessment Budget shall either appear at the hearing to express themselves or file a letter in writing with the Township Clerk before the close of the hearing.
